Call for *R&D Management Paper* for presentation

The members and non-members are encouraged to submit **technical papers on their research/experiences on R & D management** that are related to the theme of the convention. The paper should be an **original and unpublished research results or documentation of R&D management experiences of the author(s)**. The paper should contain information about the current experiences and research results that lead to improved R & D/E programs/projects of the agency, unit or organization. Before submitting a full-length paper, **interested participants must first submit an abstract of their paper**. The abstract should contain the following and be prepared as follows:

- Title of the paper should all be in capital letters. In case the title exceeds one (1) line, it should be in an inverted pyramid form.
- The underlined full name(s) of the author(s) starting from the first/given name.
- An asterisk must be placed after the name of the author who will present the paper.
- In cases where the paper has many authors presenting one or different institutions, superscript numbers should be used to indicate the author's corresponding position, institution if applicable and address.

- The use of abbreviation is not accepted. The text should start on the next line with each paragraph indented 5 columns or spaces.
- The text should be camera-ready.
- The length should not exceed to one and one-half pages.

Abstracts should be submitted on or before **28 February 2006** to the PHILARM Secretariat.

All abstracts submitted will be screened and evaluated for the award and presentation during the convention. Official communication will be sent to author (s) of the abstracts that have been considered for competition and will be advised to submit the full-length paper.

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION

1. **Relevance/significance**
 - Implications/relevance to R&D management (planning, implementation, evaluation)
 - Potential contribution to countryside development whether social, economic, ecological, etc.
2. **Organization of paper (content)**
 - Comprehensiveness
 - Overall quality of paper (validity/ reliability and dependability of results/content)
